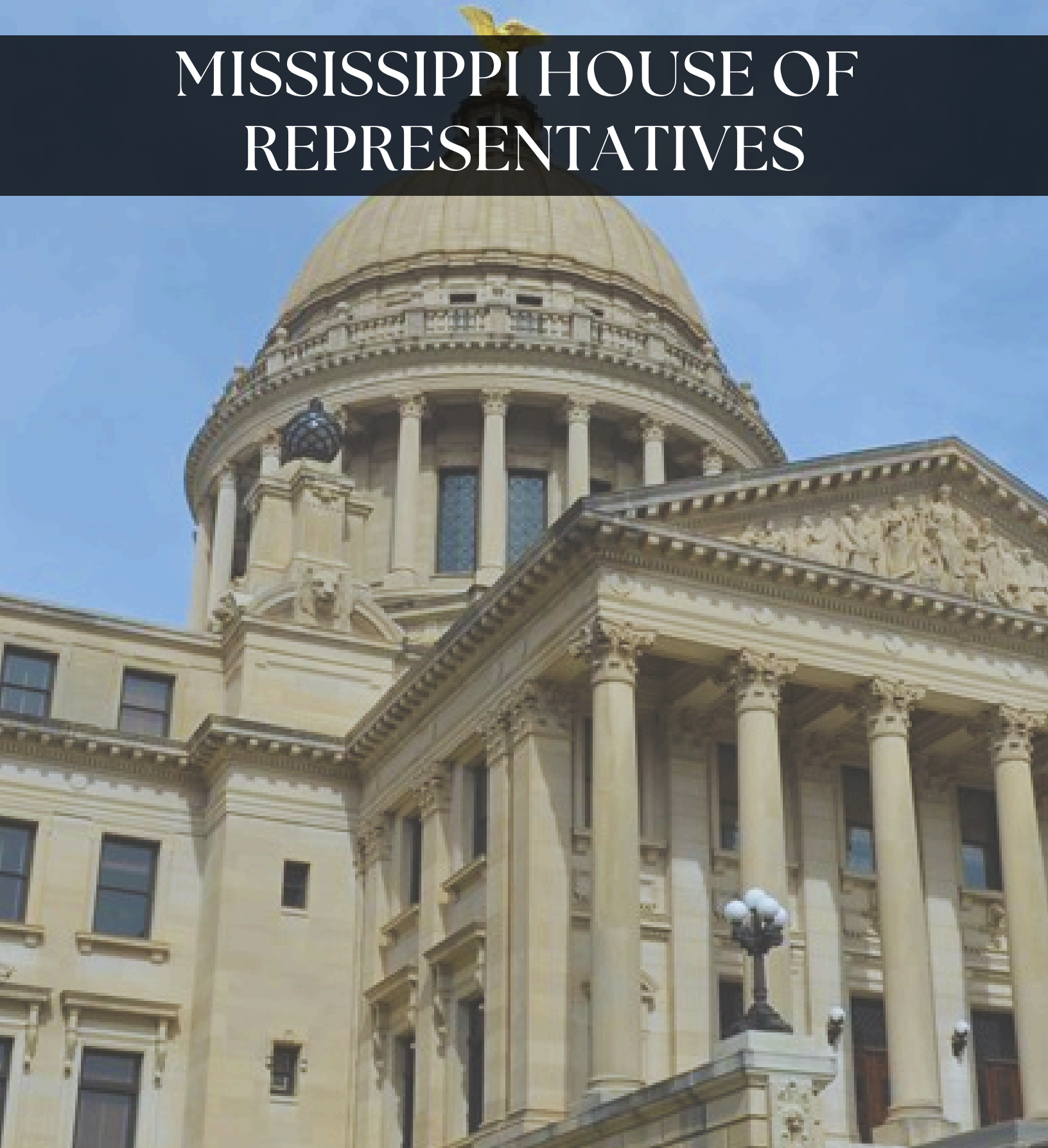

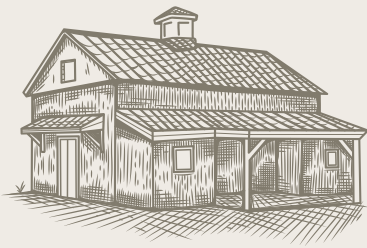


Tourism Chair Greg Haney and several others traveled to Meridian, Mississippi, for the MS Legislative FAM Tour!

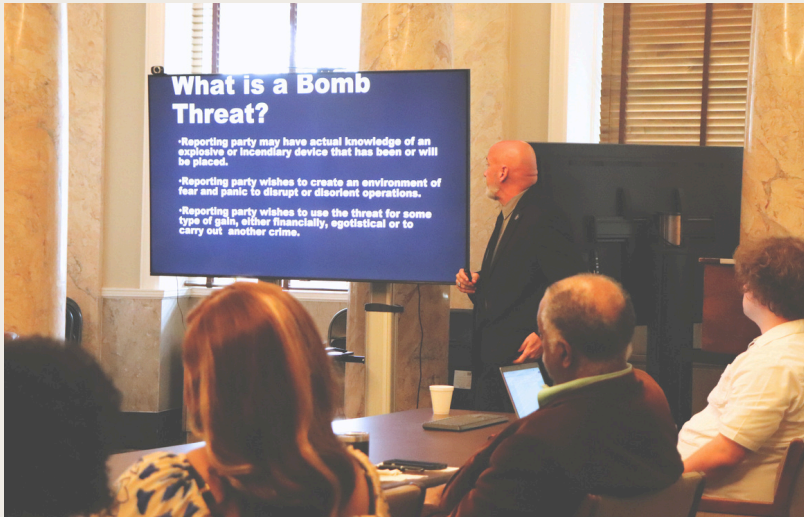

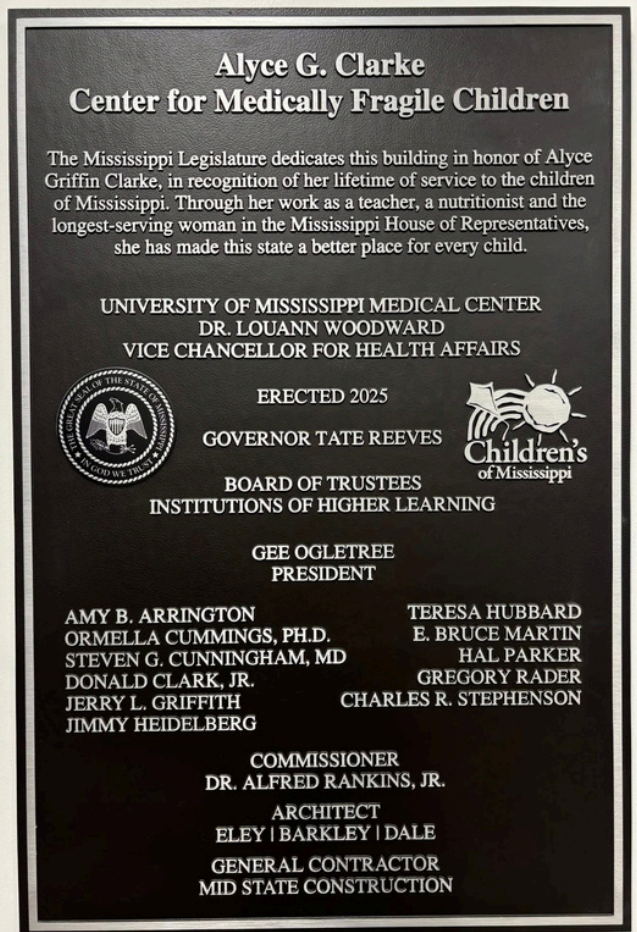
